Departure Instructions

We hope you have enjoyed your stay in the cottage. Below you will find the most important information regarding your departure.

Check out

Please check out of the cottage no later than 11:00 AM.

Dishes

A dishwasher is available. Before departure, we kindly ask you to place any used plates, cutlery and glasses in the dishwasher and start it if it has not already been run. If you prefer to wash everything by hand, that is perfectly fine as well.

Waste

We take care of the final waste disposal after your stay. A waste container is located next to the woodshed. Before leaving, please place your rubbish in this container. Glass bottles may be left on the kitchen counter.

Bed linen and towels

Please leave the beds made. There is no need to remove the bed linen. Towels and bathrobes can be left in the bathroom.

Electricity

Before leaving, please open the curtains, close all windows and doors, and switch off all lights.

Hot tub

Please empty the hot tub before departure. Turn the red valve so that it is in line with the pipe. The hot tub will drain slowly.

Before you leave

Please make sure you have collected all of your personal belongings.

Key

Please return the key to the reception of Hotel de Werelt.

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Heating & Cooling

To ensure a comfortable indoor climate throughout the year, the cottage is equipped with underfloor heating and cooling. During the summer, the system cools the floor, while in winter it provides gentle heating.

The system is preset for your comfort. In the bedrooms, you can adjust the temperature slightly up or down to suit your preference.

Please note that this is a low temperature system, so any changes to the temperature may take some time to become noticeable.

Fireplace

During the colder months, you are welcome to enjoy the wood burning fireplace in the living room. Firewood is available in the woodshed behind the cottage.

Please follow the instructions below for safe use.

Before Lighting

- Use dry firewood only.
- Have kindling and firelighters ready.
- Make sure the air vent is fully open.

Lighting the Fire

- Place 2 to 3 larger logs at the bottom.
- Stack medium sized logs and kindling on top.
- Place 1 or 2 firelighters on top.
- Light the fire, close the fireplace door, and leave the air vent fully open.

While Burning

- Once the fire is burning well, slightly reduce the airflow to create a calm, steady flame.
- Add only 1 or 2 logs at a time.
- The flames should burn gently, not roar.

Important

- Always keep the fireplace door closed while the fire is burning.
- Never burn wet wood, paper, cardboard or household waste.
- Only place enough firewood in the fireplace for the evening.
- Before going to bed or leaving the cottage, make sure the fire has completely burned out and the fireplace is safely extinguished.

Television

This apartment is equipped with a Smart TV. To access TV channels, simply turn on the TV and open the Canal+ app.

The TV can be operated using the remote control. With this remote, you can quickly and easily use the main functions of the TV, such as:

- Turning the TV on and off
- Adjusting and muting the volume
- Switching channels
- Opening the Home menu to launch apps and adjust settings
- Direct access to popular streaming services (such as Netflix and YouTube) via dedicated buttons
- Navigating menus using the arrow keys and selecting options with the OK button
- Enabling subtitles and adjusting picture and sound settings

PlayStation 4

Is the weather keeping you indoors, or are you simply in the mood to relax? No worries, the PlayStation 4 is ready for you to enjoy.

Turning On the PS4

- Turn on the TV
- Switch on the TV and make sure it is set to the correct HDMI input to which the PS4 is connected.
- In this cottage, the PS4 is connected to HDMI 2.

Turn on the PS4

- Press the Power button on the PS4.

The power indicator will first flash blue while the system starts up. Once it turns solid white, the PS4 is fully powered on.

Check the TV

- When the indicator is white, the PS4 home screen should appear on the TV.

Turning Off the PS4

- Open the Quick Menu
- Press the PS button on the controller to open the menu.
- Select Turn Off PS4.
- Wait for Shutdown
- The power indicator will flash white while the system shuts down.

Once the light goes out completely, the PS4 has been safely switched off.

Troubleshooting

No picture on the TV?

If the PS4 is on but nothing appears on the screen:

- Press and hold the Power button on the PS4 for at least 7 seconds until the system switches off completely.
- Turn the PS4 back on.
- Check that the TV is set to the correct HDMI input (HDMI 2).



Sonos Speaker

Enjoy high-quality music playback during your stay in the apartment with our Sonos speaker. Please follow the instructions below depending on your device.

First, switch on the Sonos speaker by pressing the power button located on the back. Next, press the Bluetooth button to make the speaker discoverable. It will then show up in the list of available devices on your phone or tablet. Simply select the Sonos speaker in your Bluetooth settings to connect.

For apple iOS

Connect via Apple AirPlay 2 for the best sound quality. Make sure you are connected to the cottage's Wi-Fi network and follow the steps in your preferred music app.

For android

Connect via Bluetooth by following these steps: turn on the speaker, go to the Bluetooth settings on your Android device, and select the Sonos speaker.

Please be mindful of the neighbors.

We want everyone to enjoy their stay, you and the neighbors alike. Therefore, we kindly ask you to:

- Keep the volume at a pleasant level, especially during the evening hours (after 10 PM).
- Avoid heavy bass or extremely loud music.

Combi microwave

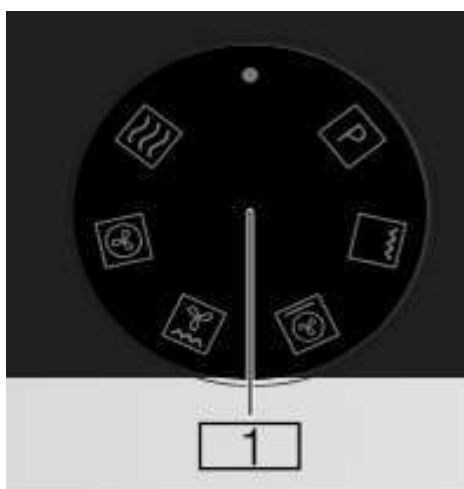
Control panel



Using the control panel, you can easily set the desired functions of your device. To do this, use the function selector button, rotary knob, and touch controls. The display always shows the current settings.

Function dial

Use the function selector to set the types of heating and other functions. If you turn the function selector from the off position to a function, it takes a few seconds for the relevant function to be available.

Combi microwave

Touch Controls

The touch control panel is located in the center below the display. By tapping the symbols on the touch panel, you can activate various functions.

Symbol	Name	Use
	Power level	Select the microwave power levels as shown in the display table for fast or slow cooking.
	Automatic cook	Call up the selection of automatic programming.
	Auto defrost	Press and hold. Activate or deactivate the defrost lock.
	Child lock	Press and hold. The settings are saved.
	Temperature	Set the temperature.
	Weight	Set the weight.
	Start	Press and hold. The settings are saved.

Rotary knob

Use the rotary knob to set the temperature and to select settings for other functions. When a function is highlighted on the display (see explanation above), you can adjust it using the rotary knob.



Microwave

You can use the microwave to cook, heat up, bake or defrost food very quickly. The microwave can be used on its own or in combination with a type of heating. Here you can find an overview of the different microwave power settings and when to use them.

Microwave output in watts	Maximum cooking time	Use
90 W	1:30 hours	Defrosting delicate foods.
180 W	1:30 hours	Defrosting food and continued cooking.
360 W	1:30 hours	Cooking meat and fish or heating delicate foods.
600 W	1:30 hours	Heating and cooking food.
900 W	30 minutes	Heating liquids. The maximum power setting is not designed for heating food.

Display

The following symbols are shown on the display:

Symbol	Name	Meaning
	Timer	If the symbol is highlighted, the timer appears in the display.
	Cooking time	If the symbol is highlighted, the cooking time appears in the display.
	Clock	If the symbol is highlighted, the clock appears in the display.
	Temperature	The time is displayed in hours and minutes.
	Weight	The time is displayed in minutes and seconds.
	Child lock	If the symbol is highlighted, the child lock is activated.
	Auto cook	If the symbol is highlighted, the auto cook is activated.
	Auto defrost	If the symbol is highlighted, the auto defrost is activated.
	Temperature	The temperature is displayed in °C.
	Weight	The weight is displayed in kg.

Heating methods

The following methods are available on this combination microwave oven. Each method is suitable for specific cooking purposes and can be used individually or in combination:

Cooktop

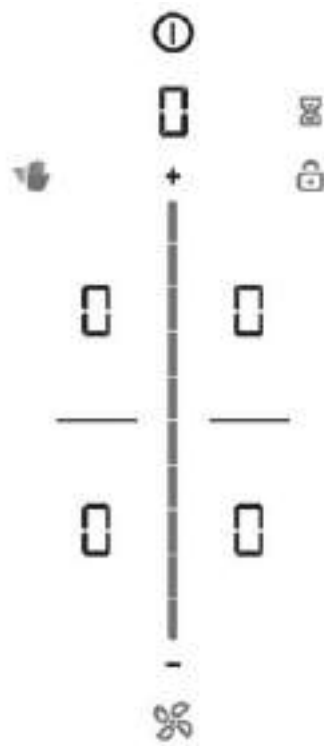
Control panel

Power on/off:

Press and hold the button to turn the cooktop on or off.

Cleaning Lock:

Press and hold the button to turn off the control panel for 10 seconds. Press and hold the button again to deactivate the lock.



Timer:

Press the timer button to activate or deactivate it. Use the + and - buttons or the slide control (- -) to adjust the time.

Lock:

Press and hold the lock button to lock or unlock the cooktop.

Cooktop ventilation:

Press the button to activate the extractor.

Use the + and - buttons or the slide control (- -) to adjust the power level

Induction Mat

The Combekk induction mats protect the induction cooktop from damage. The mats can remain on the cooktop during use.

Coffee Machine

Follow the steps below to make a cup of coffee:

Preparation

- Fill the water tank with clean water.
- Switch on the machine.
- Press the Espresso or Lungo button on the top of the machine.
- The indicator lights will start blinking: this means the machine is heating up (approx. 25 seconds).
- Insert the coffee capsule
 - Open the capsule lever fully.
 - Place a capsule into the holder.

Note: Never open the capsule lever during use!

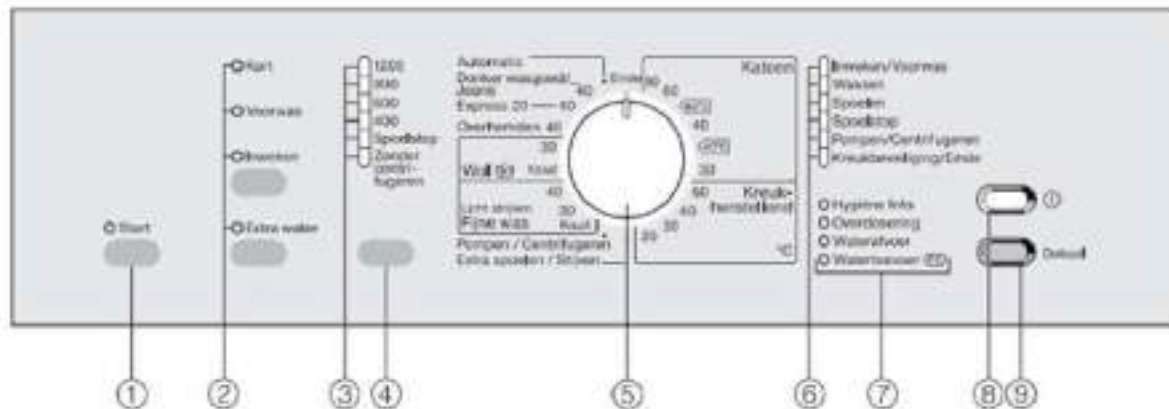
- Close the capsule lever and place a cup under the coffee outlet.
- Brew your coffee
- Press:
 - the Espresso button (for 40 ml), or
 - the Lungo button (for 110 ml).
- The machine will stop automatically after brewing.
- Remove the cup once your coffee is ready.
- Eject the used capsule
 - Lift the capsule lever and then push it back down.
 - The capsule will be automatically ejected into the used capsule container.

Washing Machine

Control Panel



No.Function

1. Start Button

Press to start the selected washing programme.

2. Extra Options

Use these buttons to enable or disable additional functions. The upper button lets you choose Short, Pre-wash, or Soak. The lower button activates Extra Water. An indicator light will illuminate when an option is selected.

3. Indicator Lights

Display the selected Spin Speed, Rinse Hold, or No Spin setting.

4. Spin Button

Adjust the spin speed or select Rinse Hold or No Spin.

5. Programme Selector

Turn the dial to select the desired washing programme and temperature.

6. Programme Progress Indicators

Show the current stage of the wash cycle while the programme is running.

7. Warning Indicators

These lights indicate if the washing machine requires attention or if a fault has occurred.

8. Power Button

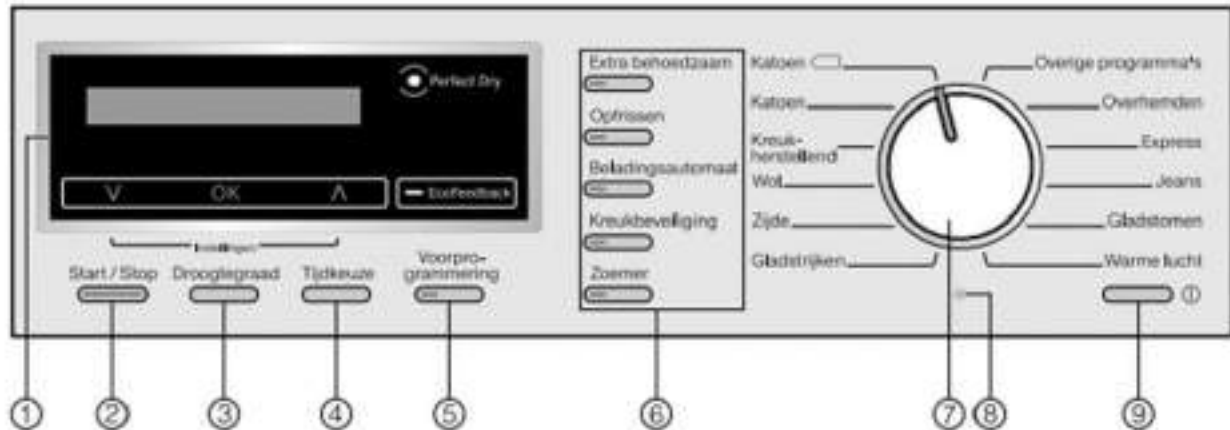
Turns the washing machine on or off and can also be used to interrupt the current programme. To save energy, the machine switches off automatically approximately 15 minutes after being left idle or 15 minutes after the programme has finished.

9. Door Button

Press to unlock and open the washing machine door.

Tumble Dryer

Control Panel



No.Function

1. Display with Touch Controls

The display shows the selected programme, remaining drying time and available settings.

2. Start / Stop

Press to start the selected programme or to stop a programme that is already running.

3. Dryness Level

Adjust the desired dryness level for programmes that support this option.

4. Time Selection

Set the drying time for timed drying programmes.

5. Delay Start

Set a delayed start time so the programme begins automatically later.

6. Option Buttons

Enable or disable additional programme options.

7. Programme Selector

Turn the dial to select the desired drying programme.

8. Service Interface

Used by service technicians for diagnostics, software updates and maintenance. No action is required by guests.

9. Power Button

Turns the tumble dryer on or off. To save energy, the dryer switches off automatically approximately 15 minutes after the programme has finished or if no buttons are pressed after switching it on.

Infrared Sauna

Enjoy the ultimate moment of relaxation in the luxury infrared sauna at the Cottage in Lunteren. The gentle, penetrating heat helps relax your muscles, stimulates circulation and leaves you feeling refreshed and re-energised. The perfect way to make your stay even more comfortable.

Control Panel

Use the control panel to switch the sauna on, adjust the temperature and set the session time to your preference.



Button	Function
Temperature + / -	Adjust the sauna temperature.
Time + / -	Set or adjust the session duration.
Power	Turn the infrared sauna on or off.
°C / °F	Switch between Celsius and Fahrenheit.
Inside Light	Turn the interior lighting on or off.
Outside Light	Turn the exterior lighting on or off.
LED	Turn the colour therapy lighting on or off.

Benefits of the Infrared Sauna

The infrared sauna can be used for a variety of purposes, including:

- Relieving muscle and joint pain
- Relaxation and stress relief
- Detoxifying the body
- Supporting muscle recovery after exercise

How the Infrared Sauna Works

Before Your Session

We recommend drinking a glass of water before using the sauna to stay well hydrated. To help keep the sauna clean and in excellent condition, please place a towel on both the bench and the floor before entering.

Preheating

Always preheat the sauna before entering. The infrared heaters require a few minutes to reach their optimal operating temperature.

The recommended preheating time is 5 to 10 minutes, depending on your preferred starting temperature and the purpose of your session.

Infrared Sauna

Purpose	Recommended Temperatures
Relieving muscle and joint pain	30°C
Relaxation and wellness	35–45°C
Detox and cleansing	35–45°C
Muscle recovery after exercise	40°C

Temperature During Your Session

The temperature inside the infrared sauna increases gradually, typically by about 1°C per minute.

For the infrared heaters to deliver maximum radiant heat, the set temperature should always be higher than the actual cabin temperature. For example, if the cabin temperature has reached 60°C, the thermostat should be set a few degrees higher to keep the infrared heaters operating at full power.

Recommended Session Duration

Infrared sauna sessions are generally longer than traditional sauna sessions because they start at a lower temperature. Most guests enjoy sessions of 20 to 30 minutes.

Everyone responds differently to heat, so always listen to your body. If you are new to infrared saunas, start with shorter sessions and gradually increase the duration as your body adapts.

The infrared sauna may be used daily. However, daily high-temperature detox sessions (above 60°C) are not recommended, as they may be physically demanding over time.

Guests with rheumatic or joint conditions may benefit from using the sauna twice a day at a lower temperature.

To maintain a comfortable temperature while still receiving the full benefits of the infrared heaters, you may simply leave the sauna door slightly open.

After Your Session

- Switch off the infrared sauna.
- Remove your towels from the cabin.
- Leave the door open to allow the cabin to ventilate properly.

Unlike a traditional sauna, there is no need to take a cold shower after your infrared sauna session.

Tips

- Drink plenty of water before, during and after your session. Fruit juice is also a good option.
- Always listen to your body and leave the sauna if you feel uncomfortable.
- If the temperature feels too warm, simply leave the door slightly open. The infrared heaters will continue operating at full power while the cabin remains at a comfortable temperature.

Hot Tub

Safety Instructions

To ensure a safe and enjoyable experience, please follow the guidelines below when using the hot tub.

- Fill before heating. Never light the wood burner until the hot tub is completely filled with water. Heating an empty tub can cause serious damage to the stove and may be dangerous.
- Empty only after the fire is out. Do not drain the hot tub until the fire has completely burned out and the stove has cooled down.
- Watch for slippery surfaces. During freezing temperatures, the area around the hot tub may become slippery.
- Never use the hot tub alone. Always ensure that someone else is nearby.
- No alcohol or drugs. Do not use the hot tub while under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
- If you feel unwell. If you become dizzy, sleepy or uncomfortable, leave the hot tub immediately and cool down in the fresh air.
- Monitor the water temperature. The recommended water temperature is 37°C to 40°C (99°F to 104°F). A lower temperature is advised for children and people with heart conditions.

Preparing the Hot Tub

Filling the Hot Tub

- The red valve is located between the wood burner and the hot tub.
- Turn the red valve counter clockwise to keep the water inside the hot tub. No drain plug is required.
- Fill the hot tub completely to the top before lighting the fire. Filling the tub takes approximately 3 hours.
- Never light the wood burner until the hot tub is completely full.

Heating the Water

- Heating the water usually takes 2 to 3 hours.
- Keep the lid on while heating to reduce the heating time.
- Stir the water regularly to distribute the heat evenly throughout the tub.

Hygiene

To help keep the water clean for as long as possible, please shower before entering the hot tub.

During Use

- Always follow the safety instructions above.
- Keep an eye on the fire and maintain a steady, controlled temperature.

After Use

When you have finished using the hot tub, allow it to drain by turning the red valve so that it is in line with the pipe. The hot tub will empty slowly.
