Welcome to the former First Aid Building, welcome to ENKA Studios.

You are staying on the historic ENKA estate in Ede, a place where history, experience, and comfort come together. The name ENKA originates from the initials N and K, representing the Nederlandse Kunstzijdefabriek (Dutch Artificial Silk Factory).

Built in 1919 to meet the growing demand for textiles, the factory transformed the small village of Ede into a thriving industrial community. What was once home to around 7,600 residents eventually grew into a town of more than 113,000 people. Over the decades, the ENKA site expanded to include its own bus service, swimming pool, and even an entire residential neighbourhood for its employees.

Following the factory's closure in 2003, the estate underwent an extensive redevelopment. Since 2011, it has evolved into a vibrant residential district where many of the original industrial buildings have been carefully preserved and given a new purpose. One of these is the former First Aid Building, now home to ENKA Studios, offering beautifully designed, fully furnished accommodations that combine industrial character with contemporary luxury.

Beneath the building lies a remarkable reminder of the past: the former Cold War bunker. Today, it has been transformed into an innovative VR experience, where history, technology, and entertainment come together.

A stay at ENKA Studios is more than just an overnight visit; it is a timeless experience. Here, you can feel the grandeur of the site's industrial heritage while enjoying modern comfort, surrounded by nature, tranquility, and stories from another era.

At the same time, Ede's town centre is within walking distance, allowing you to enjoy the perfect balance between peaceful relaxation and vibrant city life.

Available from several locations in Ede and Bennekom, these bikes can easily be rented through the BAQME app. Perfect for a day out, grocery shopping, or a scenic ride through the Veluwe. After your trip, simply return the bike to the same designated location. A practical and environmentally friendly way to discover the region.

Ede-Wageningen railway station

Ede-Wageningen railway station is within walking distance of the apartment, offering excellent connections to destinations throughout the Netherlands.

Within walking distance of the apartment, you'll find Spindop Shopping Centre, a compact and convenient shopping area for all your daily essentials. Wageningen University & Research is easily accessible by public transport. From Ede-Wageningen Station, a direct bus departs approximately every 20 minutes to the university campus.

Leaving the Building

You do not need a key tag to exit the building.

On the inside of the front door, you will find a grey, round knob.

- Turn the knob gently to the left. It will automatically continue turning to the open position.
- Once the knob has fully rotated, you can open the door.

After closing the door, the locking mechanism will automatically return to the locked position

Check-out instructions

We hope you enjoy your stay. For your information, please find below the most important details regarding your departure.

Check-out time

We kindly ask you to leave the apartment no later than 11:00 AM. Before you leave, we kindly ask you to open the curtains and ensure that all windows and doors are closed. **Please return your key by placing it in the mailbox outside the building that corresponds to your studio number.**

Dishwasher

A dishwasher is available. Upon departure, we ask you to place used plates, cutlery, and glasses in the dishwasher and turn it on if it has not yet been run. If you prefer to wash the dishes by hand, that is of course also fine.

Waste

We take care of waste disposal after your stay. During your stay, we kindly ask you to separate your waste and dispose of it in the designated bins in the apartment.

Bed and bath linen

There is no need to strip the beds; we will take care of this. Towels can be left in the bathroom.

Elektricity

Upon departure, we kindly ask you to open the curtains, raise the blinds, close all windows and doors. Please check that the electricity is actually switched off before leaving.

To set your preferred room temperature, please follow the instructions on the thermostat. For the climat control system to operate properly, please **do not switch the thermostat off**.

Please note: When darkening the room, use the roller blinds rather than the curtains. This ensures climat control can circulate air efficiently and maintain a comfortable indoor temperature.

Television

This apartment is equipped with a Smart TV. To access TV channels, simply turn on the TV and open the Canal+ app.

The TV can be operated using the remote control. With this remote, you can quickly and easily use the main functions of the TV, such as:

- Turning the TV on and off
- Adjusting and muting the volume
- Switching channels
- Opening the Home menu to launch apps and adjust settings
- Direct access to popular streaming services (such as Netflix and YouTube) via dedicated buttons
- Navigating menus using the arrow keys and selecting options with the OK button
- Enabling subtitles and adjusting picture and sound settings

Sonos Speaker

Enjoy high-quality music playback during your stay in the apartment with our Sonos speaker. Please follow the instructions below depending on your device.

First, switch on the Sonos speaker by pressing the power button located on the back. Next, press the Bluetooth button to make the speaker discoverable. It will then show up in the list of available devices on your phone or tablet. Simply select the Sonos speaker in your Bluetooth settings to connect.

For apple iOS

Connect via Apple AirPlay 2 for the best sound quality. Make sure you are connected to Wi-Fi network and follow the steps in your preferred music app.

For android

Connect via Bluetooth by following these steps: turn on the speaker, go to the Bluetooth settings on your Android device, and select the Sonos speaker.

Please be mindful of the neighbors.

Combi microwave

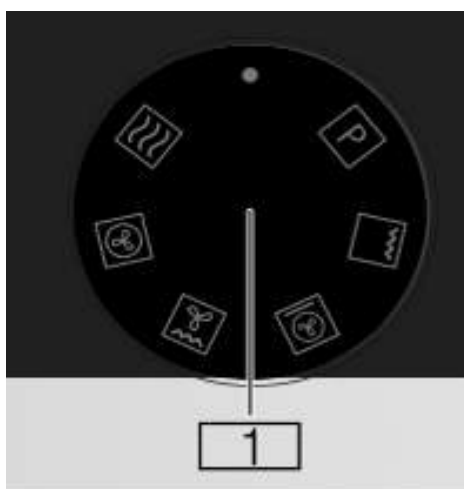
Control panel



Using the control panel, you can easily set the desired functions of your device. To do this, use the function selector button, rotary knob, and touch controls. The display always shows the current settings.

Function dial

Use the function selector to set the types of heating and other functions. If you turn the function selector from the off position to a function, it takes a few seconds for the relevant function to be available.

Touch Controls

The touch control panel is located in the center below the display. By tapping the symbols on the touch panel, you can activate various functions.



Symbol	Name	Use
[P]	Powerwave	Select the twoOutput power levels or switch on the microwave function for a type of heating.
[1]	Automatic programmes	Set in the selection of automatic programmes.
[2]	Powerful preheating/defrosting	Press briefly. Subsequent heating speed preheating.
[3]	Time setting, defrost	Press and hold. Activate or deactivate the stop/start lock.
[4]	Time setting, defrost	Time, cooking time or set the time.
Symbol	Name	Use
[5]	Temperature	Select set the temperature.
[6]	Weight	Select set the weight.
[7]	Heating	Press once, then 1 or 2 for cooking, press and hold. End operation. The settings are reset.

Rotary knob

Use the rotary knob to set the temperature and to select settings for other functions. When a function is highlighted on the display (see explanation above), you can adjust it using the rotary knob.



Microwave

You can use the microwave to cook, heat up, bake or defrost food very quickly. The microwave can be used on its own or in combination with a type of heating. Here you can find an overview of the different microwave power settings and when to use them.

Microwave output in watts	Maximum cooking time	Use
90 W	1:30 hours	Defrosting delicate foods.
180 W	1:30 hours	Defrosting food and continued cooking.
360 W	1:30 hours	Cooking meat and fish or heating delicate foods.
600 W	1:30 hours	Heating and cooking food.
900 W	30 minutes	Heating liquids. The maximum power setting is not designed for heating food.

Display

The following symbols are shown on the display:



Symbol	Name	Meaning
[C]	Time	If the symbol is highlighted, the time appears in the display.
[1-6]	Cooking type	If the symbol is highlighted, the cooking time appears in the display.
[7]	Grill	If the symbol is highlighted, the grill appears in the display.
[8]	Power intensity	The time is displayed in hours and minutes.
[9]	Temperature	The time is displayed in minutes and seconds.
[10]	Weight	If this symbol is highlighted, the 1000 gram mark is activated.
[11]	Heat setting	If the symbol is highlighted, heat setting is activated.
[12]	Temperature	The symbol is displayed in °C.
[13]	Weight	The symbol is displayed in kg.

Heating methods

The following methods are available on this combination microwave oven. Each method is suitable for specific cooking purposes and can be used individually or in combination:

Symbol	Name	Temperature/Time	Use
[14]	Microwave	800-900 W • 900 W • 180 W • 360 W • 600 W • 900 W	For defrosting, cooking and heating foods and liquids.
[15]	Hot air	40-180 °C	For roasting, baking, grilling, etc.
[16]	Hot air grilling	180-230 °C	For roasting, baking, grilling, etc.
[17]	Grill setting	100-230 °C	For cooking meat and fish that require a lot of heat from under.
[18]	Grill settings	• 1 = low • 2 = medium • 3 = high	Grilling fat items such as steaks and sausages, or melting butter.
[19]	Preprogramme		There are preprogrammed settings for many dishes.

Cooktop

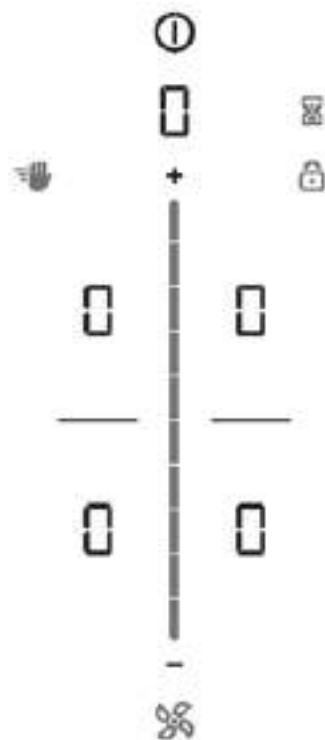
Control panel

Power on/off:

Press and hold the button to turn the cooktop on or off.

Cleaning Lock:

Press and hold the button to turn off the control panel for 10 seconds. Press and hold the button again to deactivate the lock.



Timer:

Press the timer button to activate or deactivate it. Use the + and - buttons or the slide control (- - -) to adjust the time.

Lock:

Press and hold the lock button to lock or unlock the cooktop.

Cooktop ventilation:

Press the button to activate the extractor.

Use the + and - buttons or the slide control (- - -) to adjust the power level

Induction Mat

The Combekk induction mats protect the induction cooktop from damage. The mats can remain on the cooktop during use.

Coffee Machine

Follow the steps below to make a cup of coffee:

Preparation

- Fill the water tank with clean water.
- Switch on the machine.
- Press the Espresso or Lungo button on the top of the machine.
- The indicator lights will start blinking: this means the machine is heating up (approx. 25 seconds).
- Insert the coffee capsule
 - Open the capsule lever fully.
 - Place a capsule into the holder.

Note: Never open the capsule lever during use!

- Close the capsule lever and place a cup under the coffee outlet.
- Brew your coffee
- Press:
 - the Espresso button (for 40 ml), or
 - the Lungo button (for 110 ml).
- The machine will stop automatically after brewing.
- Remove the cup once your coffee is ready.
- Eject the used capsule
 - Lift the capsule lever and then push it back down.
 - The capsule will be automatically ejected into the used capsule container.

Instructions

Indicator lights (1)

The indicator lights show the selected settings for temperature, spin speed, options and signals.

Display (2)

Shows the selected settings, such as spin speed and drying time, as well as the progress and status of the current programme.

Buttons (3)

- Temperature °C: Adjusts the washing temperature.
- Spin speed: Adjusts the spin speed.
- Options: Selects additional washing options.
- Set: Activates or deactivates the selected washing options.
- Ready in: Delays the start of the programme.
- Drying: Selects the drying options.
- Start/Pause: Starts or pauses the washing programme.

Programme selector (4)

Used to switch the washer-dryer on or off and to select a programme. The selector can be turned in either direction. Do not turn the programme selector while a washing or drying programme is running.
